The Treasurer's reports for August, September and November were forwarded to our club president and recording secretary. The August one was reported to the Board at our Sept. 15th board meeting. The other two will be reported to the Board when it next meets. Our Third Federal Bank Statements showed our checkbook ledger to be in-balance for each of those months.

President Mary Jane asked me to give you a general accounting for our current operating funds which come primarily from the dues we collect each year.

Our income for this fiscal year to date is \$1870.79 (\$1800 from dues paid by 45 members + a miscellaneous donation of \$30 + a re-deposit of \$40 from un-used funds from last fiscal year set aside for Grand Bay set up fees for our board meetings + \$ 0.79 from interest paid to date on our checking account.)

Our expenses/commitments so far this year amount to \$1,080.28 (\$110 for postage for our newsletters, \$269.28 to Alt Media for our website maintenance fee, \$25 for memorial donation, \$100 for Yule Tide Hunger center {in lieu of members' past donations of food/paper products in November}, bylaw's mandatory set aside of \$500 in operating fund to secure free checking/cover any unexpected situations, \$76 for our annual Post Office Box fee.)
